

COVID-19 CDPH* GUIDELINES

Students need to stay home if they have:

OR

ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

- □ Chills or fever of 100.4 or higher
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headaches
- New loss of taste or smell
- □ Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

ANY DIRECT EXPOSURE:

- □ Been within 6 feet of someone diagnosed with Covid-19 for more than 15 minutes
- □ Anyone living in their household has tested positive to Covid-19
- Traveled outside of California (requires 10 day quatantine upon return)

When can student return to school?

POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST

MAY RETURN AFTER 10 CALENDAR DAYS FROM START OF SYMPTOMS

AND

NO FEVER FOR 24 HOURS WITHOUT THE USE OF MEDICATION

<u>AND</u>

SYMPTOMS HAVE IMPROVED

NO COVID-19 TEST

MAY RETURN AFTER 10 CALENDAR DAYS

AND

NO FEVER FOR 24 HOURS WITHOUT THE USE OF MEDICATION

<u>AND</u>

SYMPTOMS HAVE IMPROVED

OR

DOCTOR'S NOTE INDICATING ALTERNATIVE DIAGNOSIS

NEGATIVE PCR COVID-19 TEST*

MAY RETURN AFTER 24 HOURS OR IMPROVED SYMPTOMS

AND

NO FEVER FOR 24 HOURS
WITHOUT THE USE OF MEDICATION

Negative test results MUST be emailed to: preschool@cereschristianchurch.org NOT A RAPID TEST PER CDPH*

DIRECT EXPOSURE TO COVID-19

MAY RETURN AFTER 10 CALENDAR DAYS OF LAST CONTACT WITH POSITIVE INDIVIDUAL*

AND HAVE NO SYMPTOMS

OR

MAY RETURN AFTER 20 CALENDAR DAYS
IF HOUSEHOLD MEMBER TESTS POSITIVE
AND HAVE NO SYMPTOMS

*ADDITIONAL DAYS MAY APPLY DEPENDING UPON RELATIONSHIP OF EXPOSURE
